Smoke Free Procedure - N.A.G. 5

Objectives / Aims

- 1. To provide a safe physical and emotional learning and teaching environment for all students, staff and visitors to our school that is free of the harmful effects of smoking
- 2. To provide an environment free of the harmful effects of smoking, in compliance with the Smoke Free Environment Act 2004 including current 2018 amendments, and all general legislative requirements.

Statements:

- 1. Tamahere Model Country School is a smoke free environment. There will be no smoking in the school grounds or in the school buildings
 - a. A prominent notice will be displayed indicating that smoking is not permitted.
 - b. The school will notify the children's caregivers of our policy through newsletters
 - c. The staff will stress the harmful effects of smoking, during the teaching of relevant sections of the health syllabus.
 - d. Teachers will lead by example and not smoke on school property.
 - e. Visitors to school will be encouraged to support our NO SMOKING policy.
 - f. Any complaints will be directed to the Principal.
- 2. On school camps or outdoor excursions, smokers must smoke outside the boundaries of the camp area and/or in an area out of sight or smell of the children.
