Week 2 already! Time is racing by with these short weeks. Our Meet the Teacher Evening originally timetabled for tonight in person, will now be sent home via email tomorrow, so that families can view the information at their leisure over the weekend.

Thank you for your continued support during these times and helping your children adapt to our new systems and practices. They are doing so well with the heat, masks and gate drop offs, etc.

Teachers have been busy preparing how our *Hybrid Learning* will look, if your child ends up having to stay at home isolating. At present we have a few students and their families in this situation but luckily no children from our school have tested positive, unlike surrounding schools.

We have been given specific instructions from the Health and Education Ministries on the processes we need to follow, and the information below may help you to understand how it will work.

Please be assured, that if someone in your household tests positive, we have a good contact tracing system in place, so that if there is a confirmed case who has been at school while infectious, we can rapidly identify who was a close contact of that person and we will then quickly advise those contacts of what they need to do.

## What We Need To Know If Your Child is Self Isolating

If you have been advised that your child is a **Close Contact** or a **Secondary Contact**, or you are **choosing for them to self isolate**, please let our school know so that we can link you into the Hybrid Learning, either joining our classes online, having a hard pack or online learning links. We also need to know when your child will be cleared to return to school.

## If your child is self isolating, please provide the following information to reception@tamahere.school.nz:

- 1. We need to know if your child has been classed as a Close Contact or a Secondary Contact, as the self isolation period and Government guidance differs.
- 2. If you are choosing for them to self isolate, please give details including the expected return to school date.
- 3. If your child is a Close Contact or Secondary Contact, the date of last exposure to the person with COVID19 and confirmation that the student is self isolating away from the Covid positive person, if they are living in the same household.

### SH21 Underpass Project Update - 10 February 2022

Kia ora koutou,

On the southern (Country Club) side, the kerb and channel has been poured and the footpath behind the church connecting the underpass to Tamahere Drive has been completed. This week sees the team installing guardrail and removing the temporary barriers to realign the road.

On the northern (Tamahere) side of the underpass the wall panels are in place, the ramp floor has been partially poured and the stairs constructed. This week sees the team backfilling behind the wall panels in preparation for removing the temporary sheet piling.

Prior to project completion in early March, the team will be installing lights in the underpass and handrails and fencing along the ramps. Vegetation will be planted in April / May when temperatures are cooler.
