Wiki/ Week 6 Happenings:

Kia ora Koutou

I hope you, your families and friends are all fairing as well as can be expected, in these very unusual times. So far, our school has been tracking along fairly evenly, with still only the original five classes considered close contacts and having around 28% of students away most days. I believe this is largely up to all of you, for your diligence in keeping any symptomatic children away from school when they show any signs of illness, and possibly the high vaccination rates in our area. Thank you very much for this.

We have just had notification today that two students in Pukatea 14, have now tested positive and they were on site while contagious. Both the Te Akatarere classes, Miro 13 and Pukatea 14 students would now be considered close contacts, along with the Year 5 & 6 STEPS group on Monday morning. Unless showing any signs and symptoms no one needs to isolate, unless living in the same household under Phase 3.

On the staff side, COVID seems to be impacting us more this week, with the number of staff isolating at home with family members, who have positive results growing by the day. This is expected in this pandemic peak period. We also have had one member of the office staff test positive and as a result we are running on a skeleton staff in this area, along with our Senior Leadership Team, who have been impacted. As things evolve, your children may be taught by Relievers or be joined with other classes, to cope. We have not had to do this yet and will still take as many precautions as we can.

Our teachers are so aware that every day is a precious learning day with their students at this time. They are enjoying the extra care and time they can give to the children physically in their classrooms. We are aware that many at home are not able to access the curriculum in the same way. We hope the home learning packs and Google Meets information are helping. We look forward to your children having a speedy recovery and being able to be back with us again soon.

Masks: Thank you for your support with sending your children with a number of masks to school. Getting child masks at times can be challenging and we do appreciate this. As a school we have to source and buy our own. We are happy to supply some when needed, but a number of students have become regulars! This for us is just another COVID cost and with increasing costs in many areas and a decrease in income, due to our PTA being unable to run events, we would really appreciate it, if children could bring their own masks to school please.

Kia Kaha - I hope you are coping well and we will soon be out the other side of this. Take care!

Just a reminder that our school will be closed for tuition on <u>MONDAY 14th March</u>. The school will be completely closed on Monday, as teachers will be involved in Literacy Professional Development. Before and After School Care will not be operating. COVID-19 INFORMATION UPDATE:

Changes to Isolation Period for COVID-19 cases and Household Close Contacts:

As you are probably aware, an announcement was made yesterday, that the isolation period for COVID-19 cases and their household contacts is reducing to one week, down from 10 days, as from 11.59pm this Friday.

The main changes are as follows:

- From 11:59pm on Friday, people with COVID-19 and their Household Contacts must isolate for 7 days, not 10 days.
- Household Contacts will need to have a rapid antigen test at day 3 and day 7 of their isolation period. If they become symptomatic, they should also get a test, and if the result is positive, they are required to isolate for seven days from that point.
- If a person is isolating and still has symptoms after seven days, they are advised to stay home until 24 hours after symptoms resolve.
- Once you have recovered from COVID-19, you will not need to isolate again for 3 months, if someone else in your household tests positive during that time. This is an increase from the current 28 days.


What a wonderful way to celebrate the end of the swimming season.


