Learning Conferences Booking Reminder:

Our Learning Conferences (Parent Teacher Interviews) are running from 2.20pm through to 7.00pm, next Wednesday 6th April and from 2.50pm until 5.20pm on Thursday 7th April. Maungatautari with the larger class sizes, will be starting at the earlier time of 1.20pm on Wednesday. These children will be catered for during this extra time.

Please note: Next Wednesday we will be having a shortened lunch hour and the school day will finish at the earlier time of 2.00pm. The bus will be running half an hour earlier and After School Care will also start half an hour earlier.

Normal school hours will resume on Thursday 7th April, with our learning day concluding at the usual time of 2.30pm. Conferences will begin after this.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused by our early conclusion of learning on Wednesday.

One Conference per child: So that each teacher can discuss a child's learning journey in depth with parents and caregivers, and to ensure everyone is on the same page, we ask that all parents join together for this occasion. This will help everyone involved to understand the issues and know how best to provide the support required for each child. It will also enable teachers to have the time needed to achieve conferences for every student in their class. There are not enough spaces for our split family parents to have an appointment each. We appreciate your support in this matter.

COVID Complications: If you are **unable to attend** your child's conference due to COVID challenges, please email the classroom teacher(s) concerned and they will send you a Google Meet or Zoom Link and slot you into a free gap on these evenings, so that you don't miss out. Please let them know early, so that they can fit you in.

Teacher Only Days:

Teacher Only Days: Firstly, thank you all for supporting us to have our Teacher Only Day on March 14th. We hope it wasn't too inconvenient for you. We did gain feedback, that some felt a long weekend at that time was just what many children needed, to catch their breath and have a bit of a break around mid term. As a staff, we had a very worthwhile day focusing on Literacy and new initiatives and developments that we want to use and develop, to support reading, writing and oral language in our school.

I am just giving advance notice that next term, we will be having local kaumatua and iwi leaders in to support us with our **local curriculum** and **Aotearoa Histories** development for the new Aotearoa New Zealand Histories Curriculum, which is mandated for use by all schools in 2023. We will be holding this **Teacher Only Day** on **Monday 27th July** which will give families a **4 day weekend** with the first National Holiday for **Matariki** happening on Friday 24th July, if you would like to book early for a break away.



In conjunction with our other Kahui Ako schools, (Hillcrest High School, Berkley Normal Middle School, Hillcrest Normal School, Silverdale Normal School, Newstead Model Country School, Tauwhare School and Matangi School), we may also have a further Teacher Only Day in Term 4. This has been pencilled in for the new Fielday's Friday to help assist the police with traffic flow in the area and will **likely be Friday 2nd December.** We will confirm this later as the Kahui Ako plans develop.


