Matariki becomes a public holiday in Aotearoa New Zealand on 24th June 2022, signaling the Māori New Year and is celebrated in the southern hemisphere midwinter following the rising of the star cluster Matariki (Pleiades).

The name "Matariki" is a shortening of the phrase 'Ngā mata o te ariki o Tāwhirimātea' (The eyes of the god Tāwhirimātea). It is a time to gather with family and friends to reflect on the past, celebrate the present, and plan for the future.

**Four Day Long Weekend for us!** Please remember that for our school we have an extra long four day weekend, with MATARIKI happening on **Friday 24th June**, combined with our **TEACHER ONLY DAY** on **Monday 27th June**.


