Having our school located within the environs of Maniapoto Pa and having one of New Zealand's Top 10 most influential people - Wirimu Tamihana (King Maker), as part of our local Ngaati Hauaa Hapu and Iwi whakapapa, we live in a very significant part of our Aotearoa New Zealand history. Thank you for enabling our Teacher Only Day to occur. Having professional learning opportunities where all staff members can come together is very valuable for us.

Our final Accord Teacher Only Day, gifted to us with NZEI negotiations for the last three years, was originally timed to coincide with the National Fieldays event which is usually held in the middle of June. As this event has now been postponed to December 2022, our Teacher Only Day also has had to be postponed. However Fieldays Friday on Friday 2nd December is going to be tough for parents and of no real benefit to our teachers. Therefore we plan to have our NZEI Accord Teacher Only Day on Monday 14th November to help support teachers with their end of year assessments and report writing. We hope this advanced notice gives you plenty of time to arrange for your children's care at a busy time of year. It also gives a long weekend / mid term break to catch a bit of extra rest for tired children.



Learning Conferences in Week 2, Term 3

Thursday 4th August: 1.30pm closing!

Mid Year reports will be going home with your children in Week One next term. We will be holding Parent Teacher Learning Conferences on Thursday 4th August. This is early notification that we will be stopping instruction at 1:30pm on this day, to allow more time for our Learning Conferences to occur. We will be having a shortened lunch break and running different learning times for the day. We hope to have the bus running an hour earlier and After School Care will also start an hour earlier.

We always look forward to hosting our learning conferences. Having strong links between school and parents is so important in supporting children's learning and for everyone to be on the same page. Understanding how things are going for your child in both environments, really helps to cater for their individual needs as best as possible.

This year, to allow time for our larger classes, some of our Learning Conferences (Parent, teacher and student conversations) will start from 10.30am and will run throughout the day and evening until 7.00pm. The information and code to book into conference slots online will be sent to you next week.

Please be aware of the following:

- Different classes have different slots: To cater for children being at school as well as having conferences, not all classes will be having learning conferences at the same time, <u>until after 1.30pm</u>. Families with children in all syndicates may prefer to book into later slots, to help accommodate your needs.
- 2. One Conference per child: So that each child can celebrate their learning journey with the ones they love and get all caregivers on the same page with the support required, we ask that all parents join together for this occasion to support your child and enable teachers to have the time needed for all conferences. There are not enough spaces for our split family parents to have an appointment each. We appreciate your support in this matter.
- **3. Berkley Normal Middle School (BNMS) Information Evening:** We see the BNMS information evening is on the same night, so we recommend our Year 6 parents select earlier slots during the day, to avoid a clash.
- **4. Technology:** With the use of technology e.g. Zoom and Google Meet, if you are unwell please don't come on site. Instead, we will organise a face-to-face online conference. This could also be used as an option to include your spouse or partner in the interview via a phone conference.
- 5. **COVID & Wellness Protocols**: As with our normal school protocols, please sanitise on the way in and wear a mask to your conferences, so that our teachers can stay well and be able to keep on teaching after our Learning Conferences. Thank you.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused by our early conclusion of the day but felt this was easier for families, rather than setting a whole day aside.


