

Lambs are \$65 each, and this money can be refunded on the return of a weaned, healthy lamb after Ag Day. Amy is also able to offer advice on rearing.

Orphan boy lambs available from a sheep milking farm to be raised. Can be neutered on the Animal Vet Health day to be held at school early September.



Lambs & Goats:

Contact Brooke: 021488854 We now have lambs available for Ag Day. They can either be returned after Ag Day or kept. Our kids are available too but please note we do not take goats back. Ready now.



Calves:
