Sun Safety - The children will be outside for most of the day so will be exposed to the heat of the sun. Sun cream will be available, students will be asked to wear sunscreen to school and to re-apply during the day, and to wear their whanau shirts and school sun hats.

The children will rotate in age gender groups around all events. Children are expected to participate in all events, as they have been practising at school and this is part of the Physical Education and Health curriculum. It is also a great time to support friends.

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
Tamahere School Pool Swim Lessons in Term 4




The cost is \$18 per lesson paid per term.
