Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Pirongia Syndicate is excited to offer the opportunity for students to bring a Chromebook to assist their learning in 2023.

What device should I buy?

We suggest only buying a Chromebook if you were to buy anything at all, as this requires the student to login with their school account every time they use it. In this way, we can more simply protect the students with online safety.

If you are looking at purchasing a new Chromebook here are a few facts to help you decide.

Chromebook

- · Choose one with robust screen and hinge design.
- . More than 4GB RAM.
- · Long battery life (to last the full day).
- 11-12 inch screen. Because students need to bring home their device everyday and a screen size around 11-12 inch would be more lightweight and portable to carry.

What will it cost?

We have negotiated special deals with PB Tech and Noel Leeming for BYOD Chromebooks which you can find attached to this letter. You do not need to buy from these stores, you are invited to find the best deal possible for your family.

Can we bring any Chromebook

Yes, however, it is essential that the device has a battery life to last a full school day (chargers are not allowed at school). Any new Chromebook will achieve this, but older devices may have batteries that hold less of a charge. Also, we suggest a newer Chromebook as this runs all apps. The older Chromebooks can have trouble accessing programmes used at school, such as Lexia.

If possible, we would recommend Chromebook models with 4GB RAM (working memory) to allow for better multi-tasking.

What else do we need to purchase?

It is highly recommended that students have a protective case/bag for their device and a set of headphones.

How are Apps installed?

Chromebooks have Apps pre-installed against your student's @tamahere.school.nz account. So, when a student logs into a Chromebook with their @tamahere.school.nz address, they will have all of the school Apps in their Apps launcher. (Note, if your child does not know their @tamahere.school.nz account details this will be cleared up when they start school in 2023. Some students already have this information.)

Can the devices stay at school?

We ask that students charge their devices at home. We have investigated installing charging lockable charging stations, but believe they are not a good solution due to cost, space and usage requirements.

If a student has a genuine reason to leave their device at school occasionally, they can negotiate this with their teacher who will ensure the device will be secure until the next day.

How do I insure my device?

Please contact your insurance company to arrange policy cover for the device at school. When your child is not in class a cabinet will be provided for your child to secure their device in.

What happens at the start of the year?

During the first week, and during the year, a Digital Citizenship programme will be run, after this, we will invite students to bring along their device, along with the attached and signed Student Agreement.

Is there anything to do once we purchase a device?

We have attached a How To Set Up Your Child's BYOD Chromebook Guide along with this letter, please set up your Chromebook accordingly after you purchase it.

If you choose to use the Family Link App, please select **NO** at the option "Control for signing in" otherwise it will ask for a "Parent Access Code" every time your child needs to login their device.
