#### LAST DAY OF SCHOOL /SCHOOL BUS OF THE YEAR:

We are pleased to be able to advise that the last day for the School Bus run this year is also our final day of school. **School finishes on THURSDAY 15TH DECEMBER AT 12.30pm**. The bus will depart at the earlier time of 12.35pm on our final day.

#### **GETTING READY FOR 2023:**

### **AFTER SCHOOL CARE CHARGES FOR 2023**

We are sorry to have to notify you of a price increase for next year. Like everyone in the country we have been hit with increased costs, we want to maintain the care that we provide for your children and to do that, we have to increase the charge. As from February 2023, the hourly charge will increase to \$8 per hour – capped at \$80 per week for 1 child, \$160 per week for 2 children and \$210 per week for 3 children. Before School Care charges will not be changed at this stage.
