Fieldays Week Update:

As emailed to our school community earlier this week, there was an error in last week's newsletter, which we want to draw your attention to. There **will be no** Teacher Only Day this year on the Friday of Fieldays.

In past years, to support Fieldays traffic management plans, we have been able to schedule a Teacher Only Day, as long as we made up the day at the end of the school year.



This year the Ministry of Education has allocated each school two specific mathematics curriculum days. These days have to be taken when there are trained facilitators available and unfortunately ours could not be achieved on Field Days Friday. Our Kahui Ako however, has a combined Teacher Only Day for the 9 schools in our Kahui Ako, on Friday 30th May, which has been booked since last year. This day will focus on cultural diversity and competencies. We hope our second mathematics curriculum Teacher Only Day will occur in Term 3 but the allocated date has not been released yet.

Walking Bus to School During Fieldays' Week

We know that Fieldays' Week is incredibly challenging for busy families trying to get to work and cover all bases. Last year we introduced a 'walking bus', which worked extremely well to save stress and long hours in traffic.

Please be aware that families needing to go North East on Tauwhare Road will be unable to do so during Fieldays' Week and will have to drive into Hamilton and back around. There will also be no right turn out of Pencarrow Road.

These walking buses would operate, weather permitting, on Wednesday 11th, Thursday 12th and Friday 13th June, but only if we have enough parent volunteers across the three days.

For families impacted by the traffic management measures, one group could meet at the end of Bruntwood Road and a group all walk together - walking bus style, the 1.6 km to school, using the new lights and crossings with one or two volunteer parents.

The same could happen from Woodcock Road with a 1.3km walk, and another group from Pencarrow Road and surrounding areas, could meet at St Stephens and use the underpass to walk around 500-700m across to the backfield.

If you are interested in this idea, can you please let the office know and we will try to coordinate the groups. The Fieldays traffic management may also be able to help the walkers to cross the Hamilton off-ramp for safety.

PINK SHIRT DAY 2025 - Friday 16th May:

Next Friday 16th May, our school will be celebrating Pink Shirt Day. This day promotes kindness and inclusiveness, encouraging students to prevent bullying through love (Aroha) and empathy. It's about promoting a community where everyone feels safe, valued, and respected.





